Select the mobile device that you will be using.

If you select **BlackBerry**, you will be taken to a screen with a link to download the app.

Select the link and follow the instructions.

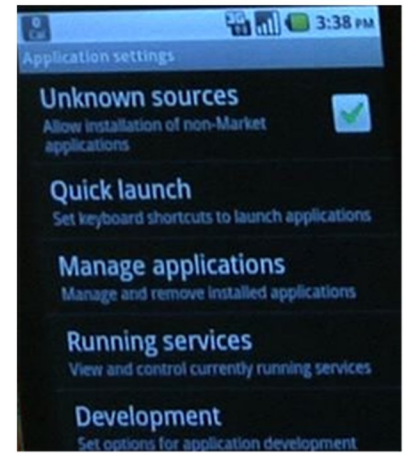
Once the download is complete you can access the app from your Downloads folder on your BlackBerry.

Note that this app is only compatible with BlackBerry 9000 and 9700 models.

If you select **Android**, the download will begin immediately.

Since the app is not being downloaded from the Android market, you may have to adjust your settings to allow the download.

To do this, go to Application settings and check the box labeled Unknown sources.



If you select **iPhone**, you will be redirected to the App Store.

Select the button that says Free, then select Install.

You will need to be signed in to an iTunes account to download the app.

If you do not already have an iTunes account, you can create one by going to the App Store on your iPhone and scrolling down to the bottom of the screen.

Select sign in, and a screen will pop up asking if you want to use an existing account or create a new one.

Select Create New Account and follow the instructions.

You can also go on your computer and open iTunes to create an account or to download the app. Note, the instructions for iPad are the same as for iPhone.

If you have a smart phone that is not compatible, or just want to use the app on your computer, you can utilize the **Web App** by selecting either Website or Mobile Website.

The Web App is a webpage designed for easy viewing on mobile devices. It can be accessed by phone, computer, or any other device with an active Internet connection.
